

## **EuroMemorandum 21st Workshop on Alternative Economic Policy in Europe**

**Roskilde University (Denmark), 24-26 September 2015**

### **Practical Information**

#### ***Travel***

Copenhagen Airport (CPH) has convenient connections to all major European airports. All flights arrive at Terminal 3, where you will also find the railway station. Trains to Copenhagen Central Station ('København H') leave frequently and take ca 15mins.

There are also good train connections from Berlin and Hamburg available.

Roskilde University has its own train station, called 'Trekroner'. There are frequent trains from Copenhagen Central (and Copenhagen Nørreport station) every hour – you can find the next connection on [www.rejseplanen.dk](http://www.rejseplanen.dk). Make sure that the train indeed stops at Trekroner, some of the fast trains only stop at Roskilde. The train from Copenhagen takes ca 25mins.

From Roskilde station, you can either take the train back towards Copenhagen and get off at Trekroner (ca 2mins), or get the Bus 220 from the station.

From Trekroner station, follow the other people across the station square and the footbridge towards the pond. The workshop will take place in building 25, right next to the pond (entrance around the corner of the building). You can find a map of the university campus [here](#).

#### ***Accommodation***

There are several accommodation options available.

- The workshop hotel is Hotel Prindsen in Roskilde ([www.prindsen.dk](http://www.prindsen.dk)). We have reserved a number of rooms at a discount price.  
Single Room = 905 DKK per room per night  
Double Room = 1005 DKK per room per night

In order to receive the discount, you need to email/call them directly with your booking request, using the reference 207669. The discount code will be valid for bookings until late July, afterwards the full rate will apply.

Hotel Prindsen is located directly in Roskilde city centre, 6-8minutes walk from the station.

- If you would like to stay in Roskilde, but at a cheaper rate, there is also a nice Youth Hostel <http://www.danhostel.dk/hostel/danhostel-roskilde> Next to dorms they also have single and double rooms. The hostel is very beautifully located at the harbour and offers good quality accommodation, but it fills up quickly during the summer months so we would advise you to book as early as possible.

- If you would rather stay in Copenhagen, we have reserved a number of rooms at a discount price at Hotel Ibsens (<http://www.arthurhotels.dk/dk/ibsens-hotel/>) close to Nørreport Station (with direct trains to Trekroner station). Single rooms are 744DKK per night.
